

Itinerary for Nadia and Alex Krongolm, April 13-May 6, 2008

April 13 -- Arrive in Minneapolis, met by Pr. Don Richman.

April 13-15 – Stay with Pr. Don Richman; visit Luther Seminary’s Global Mission Institute, meet Pastor Michael Albrecht and visit St. James Lutheran; Paul and Carol Anderson meet them there and drive them back to Don's

April 16 – Depart ≈ 8:30 a.m. from Don’s home with Carol and Paul Anderson, visit Crossways International (www.crossways.org) with Dr. Pastor Harry Wendt at 9:00 a.m.. Then drive to Springfield, Minnesota, to meet with David Milbrath and Scott Mattison (they were at the FELCs last year) and a gathering of members of their church and other churches and others (Nadia and Alex to give a presentation about their ministry, tell their story). Scott wants to talk to them about an EEMN Camp in January. On the way stop at Carol's sister's farm in Glencoe (west of Minneapolis) for lunch and a visit.

April 17 -- Drive to Columbus, Nebraska, where they will be hosted by Pastor Wayne Nestor (who has written to them about the details of their participation) and Sr. Pastor Tim White and others from Trinity Lutheran Church who were at the Camp in 2007 to participate in Trinity’s 3-day Mission Festival. Will be met there by Pastor Bill Moberly, Director of EEMN.

April 21 -- Drive back to Minneapolis with Carol and Paul; visit University of Nebraska Medical Center en route

April 21-26-- Stay with Don Richman that week, hosted by Bill and Don, who have various visits and meetings planned. Friday night, April 25th, is the EEMN banquet where Nadia and Alex are the featured speakers and Saturday April 26th is the Orientation for Camp (Paul and Carol will be at both).

April 26/27 -- Saturday evening at St. James Lutheran Church with youth (Nadia and Alex to give a presentation about their ministry, tell their story, participate in “talent” show) visit St. James worship services Sunday morning (introduced and give a greeting), visit and lunch with St. James Lutheran Church Mission Committee Sunday p.m. (hosted by Pastor Michael Albrecht and Paul and Carol Anderson).

April 28 -- Visit the Convention of the new church organization, Lutheran Church in Mission for Christ, with Bill Moberly, then depart for Duluth with Paul Anderson early afternoon, visiting the youth gathering at First Lutheran Church that evening. Stay with Paul and Carol Anderson until their departure May 6.

April 29 -- Visit Community Bible Study Children’s Program in the morning. Meet Bishop Peter Strommen and Pr Karen Bockelman at 11 a.m. Meet with First Lutheran youth leaders for lunch. "Dessert" that evening with First Lutheran’s Mission Board and "Friends of Nadia and Alex" at home of Paul and Carol Anderson, presentation/discussion by Nadia and Alex about their ministry, tell their story.

April 30 -- Meet at 10:30 a.m. with folks from the Range and Grand Rapids area churches at United in Christ Lutheran Church in Eveleth hosted by Prs. Joel and Emily Rova-Hegener, presentation/discussion by Nadia and Alex about their ministry, tell their story. After lunch a scenic drive to Two Harbors (via Gooseberry Falls) for dinner at 6:30 p.m. with youth and adults at Bethlehem Lutheran Church (hosted by Pastor Phil Berge) followed by presentation/discussion by Nadia and Alex about their ministry, tell their story at 7:00 p.m. Emmanuel Lutheran Church (hosted by Pr. Dennis Peterson) with other local churches who do their Confirmation programs together.

May 1 – Evening (7 p.m.) with folks invited from churches in Duluth, Sandstone, Mora, Brainerd area at Our Saviors Lutheran in Cloquet hosted by Pastor David and Stephanie Carlson and Pastor Rollie and Tracy Bockbrader, presentation/discussion by Nadia and Alex about their ministry, tell their story.

May 2 -- Meeting at First Lutheran Church with ELCIR Task Force 10:00 a.m., open to Synod, presentation/discussion by Nadia and Alex about their ministry, tell their story. Meet from 1-3 p.m. with Catherine Anderson (Synod Youth Coordinator) and Synod Youth Leaders and Adults interested in youth at “Split Rock 1” at the DECC before Synod Assembly, presentation/discussion by Nadia and Alex about their ministry, tell their story. Attend Synod Assembly, Nadia and Alex will be introduced and give a greeting in the

evening.

May 3 -- Attend Synod Assembly until later afternoon, attend Duluth-Superior Symphony Orchestra concert that evening.

May 4 -- Visit First Lutheran Church, introduced at each service and give a greeting, present an Adult Forum between the two services (presentation/discussion by Nadia and Alex about their ministry, tell their story). Spend some time with Pastor David and Stephanie Carlson and family Sunday p.m., dinner with them.

May 5 -- Visit Community Bible Study Leader's meeting in the morning, presentation/discussion by Nadia and Alex about their ministry, tell their story

May 6 -- Drive to Minneapolis airport, depart at 3:10 p.m.
