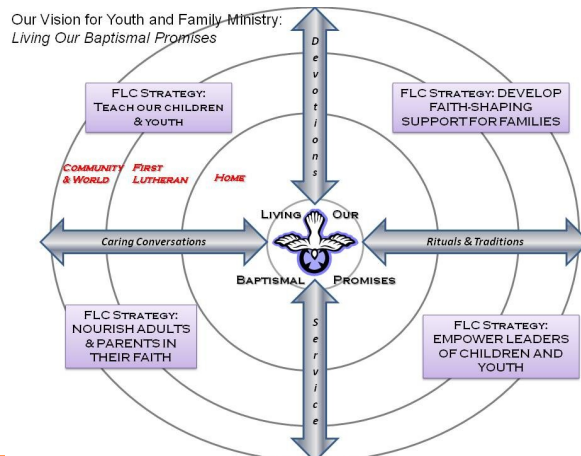
Our Baptismal Promises
