- 1. April offerings were down a little as were the Holiday offerings

We would purchase this with Memorial money that has been given and is meant to be used. This could be a great way to remember people and there are many creative options to use this in the sanctuary.

Business:

- **1.** Kelly's expanded hours have been approved. She is working with Aine and formalizing building use contracts. Working with Realm Accounting and Membership software.
- **2.** Michael Fuchs and Brian and 2 Sound Techs hired and will need 1/Sunday. We will be up and working in July
- **3.** Reopening: Dave informs us the plan is June 6. Goal will be 80 in the Sanctuary, all wearing masks, no singing. Questions of how to do communion have been addressed. Staff in the building are no longer masking. We have approved groups to again use the building. There was a wedding recently in the building.
- **4.** Many groups use the building. Kelly will manage contracts, the calendar and space issues.
- **5.** We will need to address how video equipment can be used by various groups and we will need to have fee schedules.
