Treasurer's Report: Led by Mary Dontje

- 1. April offerings were down (only about 84% of plan)
- 2. Lent Offerings were good and these are donated
- 3. Easter Offerings were also good
- 4. Year To Date we are about 86% of budgeted plan.
- 5. Expenses are up but still lower than budgeted plan.
 - a.) Issues with Office Expense Line at 434% is due to a billing from a printing place that only bills biannually so 2021 was billed in 2022
 - b.) We had a copier expense that was also high
 - c.) Some Property expenses were up
 - d.) Worship—had to pay Musicians for Seven Last Words music

Overall we are still ahead of budget but down from the amount we planned to be ahead.

- 6. 3 year comparison: very comparable
- 7. TFR still trending down. This is the 4^{th} month of offerings not matching payments
- 8. Refinanced the 7 year loan at 4.5% to \$204,000
